

UNAT Emergency General Meeting of 10/14/2012out

The meeting started at about 5:45pm with an open prayer by Jerry. The chairman welcomed members and the minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted. The financial secretary gave us a rundown of the financial statement of our account for the end of September. Our balance was as follows.

Donation account: \$2214.89

Special Account: \$886.90

Operating Account: \$2645.57

Grand Total \$5745.36

The financial secretary called on members to pay up their dues. He also reminded members that he is yet to receive money for the \$75 levy we levied ourselves in other to come up with funds for the celebration.

The chairman called on the members of the different committees on fund raising to give account of the progress they had made in raising funds for our upcoming activities. Clinton told the house that he had not able to get anything from the IB and Bony Crest. He said they had promised to get back to him, but he was still waiting to hear from them. He said he would try and get in touch with them once more.

Moses told the house that Christ the King Miracle Church had promised to give the group \$500 and that he was going to get it the following Sunday. Yinka also said that those he contacted had not gotten back to him and that he would try again to get in touch with them.

On the basis of the not encouraging report, the chairman appealed to members to pay up their \$75 levy. He also hinted that one of his contact had promised to mail him a check. He said that it will be good if members all can help raise funds

for the association by buying advertisement slots for our families and friends. The idea of the Nigeria House was discussed and members agreed that it would be good to raise funds for this project during the celebration and a separate account be set up for it.

Members were told to come out in large numbers to support one of our own who had a wedding ceremony on October 28, 2012. Our general meeting for this month was moved to Sunday the 29th October. With no other business for the day, the meeting was adjourned with closing prayer from Clinton at 9.15pm.
